The key responsibilities of this role include:

- Acting up in the absence of the Headteacher
- SENCo (with NASENCO qualification or willingness and ability to obtain the SENCO NPQ within 3 years of appointment)
- Teaching a Year Five/Six Class initially
- Leading assessment throughout the school
- Subject lead for computing and a number of areas of the curriculum to be decided upon the appointment of the successful candidate.
- Deputy Safeguarding Lead.

- Enthusiastic and passionate about making learning experiences meaningful and designing a stimulating curriculum for all
- Keen to embed all of our Christian Values 'Hope, Perseverance, Respect, Thankfulness, Forgiveness and Community' through their practice

- Eager to positively contribute to the wider school development, working within a committed team
- Willing to be involved in extracurricular activities
