Transfer to Secondary School

The application process for transfer from primary to secondary for September 2023 is underway. On-line applications, if you live in Shropshire, via www.shropshire.gov.uk/schooladmissions. It is essential that applications be made before the **closing date of 31 October 2022**. If your current address lies outside Shropshire, you need to make an application through your home local authority before the closing date of 31 October 2022. If you intend to name a Shropshire school as one of your preferences, you can do so in application via your home authority.
