

## *Classroom News*

### *Class 1*

In Class 1, the children have been carrying on our theme 'All about me', by baking miniature versions of themselves out of gingerbread! The children then looked at their features closely in a mirror, to see what colour eyes and hair they had, and decorated their biscuits accordingly.

We have also been learning to recognise and write the sounds 't', 'p' and 'i', and know more about the numbers '2' and '3'.

### *Class 2*

We are really beginning to get into the swing of our Forest School programme and everyone is enjoying our Muddy Monday sessions. We have been observing the seasonal changes around us, identifying trees and flowers by their leaves, fruits and seeds and we have enjoyed working together to create works of art out of the natural materials around us in our Forest School environment. This week, just as we reached our Forest School site, a beautiful rainbow appeared which framed a lovely picture of autumn colours. We enjoyed learning to make a dog log (ask a Class 2 pupil for details) and when we returned to class we all thought about how Forest School had made us feel. What a wonderful start to the week!

### *Class 3*

In Class 3 this week, we have been continuing with our descriptive writing.

We looked at different ways to begin our sentences.

In R.E., we are looking at the Creation Story, thinking about what the story in the Bible means for Christians.

In P.S.R.H.E., we have started to look at one of our British Values, Democracy. We are thinking about what it means and how it is maintained in our society.

### *Class 4*

In Science, as part of our Living Things and their habitats topic, we have looked and identified the different parts of the anatomy of an egg. We drew a detailed diagram to represent this.

In maths this week, we have been looking at adding and subtracting using written methods and applying our knowledge to word problems. In English this week, we have been looking at tenses and the structure of an autobiography. This will help us next week where we will be writing our own autobiographies!
