Road Safety

Class 3PH took part in Shropshire Council's 'Stepping Out' road safety training programme on Wednesday of this week. The morning included classroom-based activities and worksheets with two practical sessions at the roadside, which was organised and supported by the Road Safety Officer and school staff. The scheme has been developed to help children between the ages of seven and nine to acquire basic pedestrian skills and increase their awareness on deciding how and where to cross the road safely. As students in years 5 and 6 missed this training due to COVID, they also took part in class-based activities and worksheets.

Dental Health Presentation

Helen Webster, School Nurse, visited Classes 1W and 2B this week, to discuss the importance of dental health. Students learned what we need our teeth for, what healthy teeth look like, what causes tooth decay and the importance of brushing teeth correctly with fluoride toothpaste twice a day. They watched a YouTube video of what can happen to your teeth if you do not look after them properly and a correct brushing technique demonstration.

Statutory Assessment Tests

KS2 tests will take place the week beginning 9th May; a separate timetable has been given out to Year 6 pupils.

Year 2 students will be sitting statutory SATs tests during the month of May and Year 1 will be taking Phonics tests the week commencing 6th June.

It is vital that all pupils in year groups taking National Government Assessments are in school during the necessary weeks.
