# CLASS NEWS

## Class 1

We have continued with our Winter topic this week in Class 1. In Numeracy, the children have been investigating halves and quarters, doing lots of practical activities to embed this. In Literacy, we have been writing creative stories, inspired by a book written at home by Bodhi, about finding a powerful crystal. In Science, we have continued with our theme of animals, learning all about their different diets. The children were able to group animals together, and learned the terms carnivore, omnivore and herbivore. In R.E, we have continued with our theme of 'Being Special', writing an account of a christening. Finally, as it was 'NSPCC National Number Day' today, we wanted to do lots of activities based around number. We started off in the hall doing a maths 'Super-movers' session, followed by some child-initiated number activities. Then we watched 'Numberblocks Live' altogether to try and do some problem solving. Year 1 have been given some follow-up activities to do for homework. Have a great weekend everyone!

## Class 2

The weeks are whizzing by in Class 2! Only one more to go and that will be a Half Term gone since Christmas! We have continued our Fire of London topic, looking at what different sources of evidence tell us and also reasons why the fire became so severe. In our Literacy unit, we are preparing to write a book blurb for a sequel to The Killer Cat. We have continued to work on our mental addition in maths; next week we will look at the relationship between addition and subtraction. On Wednesday, we enjoyed the penultimate session of Reading the Game, writing a letter to Joe Hart, which was fun. We are looking forward to our last session next Wednesday. Today in R.E. we learned about the Jewish festival of Hannukah; why it is important and how it is celebrated. Next week there will be much to finish and enjoy before we break up. ## Class 3

We have had a great week continuing our work looking at the Lion, Witch and the Wardrobe. We have been completing character profiles and looking at key features of writing informal and formal letters. The children have shown an excellent understanding of the characters and we all look forward to continuing with our work linked to this next week. The children once again had a great time during our Forest School session and are already looking forward to next week. In History the children have been finding out about the Egyptian Gods. All the children have access to Times Table Rockstars, hopefully all will be able to access at home. Have a great weekend everyone!

## Class 4

Another busy week in Class 4. We have been looking at both column and grid methods of multiplication this week, in addition to the bus stop method of division. We have been particularly looking at enhancing our understanding and being able to explain our answers fully. In English, we have read more of the class text 'The Call of the Wild', and it's certainly been an emotional rollercoaster so far! Fortunately, we have ended on a happier note with 'Buck' finally meeting a human who cares for him. We have also been looking at the best ways to communicate in computing this week and have looked at sources in history linking to King Alfred in our Anglo-Saxon topic. 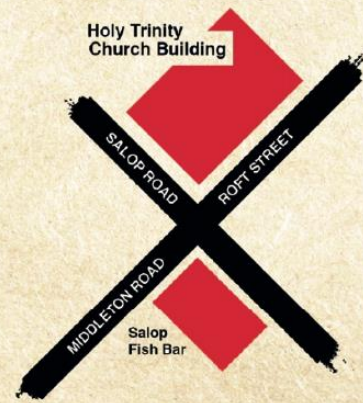
