# **CLASS NEWS**

## Class 1

We have had a lovely week in Class 1! In Literacy, we have continued reading our class text 'The Night Box', taking a closer look at the language used, and why the author chose certain words for impact. In Phonics, Reception have learned the 'h' and 'b' phonemes, taking part in lots of activities to embed the sound, including setting up our 'Hedgehog House under the Hedge'. Year 1 children have been learning all the different ways the 'or' phoneme can be written, i.e 'aw, au and al'. In Numeracy, the children have been comparing groups, using the terms more, fewer and equal to. Year 1 have also been learning how to read and write numbers in words to twenty. They have a test on number words to ten on Monday. (Sheet in their bag.) The children also worked in pairs to find different ways of representing the number ten. In Science, the children worked in mixed age pairs, to find different materials both in class and on the playground. The aim was to find five different objects, name them and work out what material they were made from. Lastly, on Wednesday, we were very lucky to have Mrs Jane Webber come to visit us and bring her 'Advent in a box'. The children used their prior knowledge of the Nativity, to use clues in each box, to guess each part of the build up to the birth of Jesus. At the end of the session, children were able to take their box home, with a symbol inside from each part of the story. Have a great weekend everyone!

## Class 2

What a whirlwind of a week! We have been extremely busy with a combination of lessons as usual, termly tests, Christmas singing and rehearsing and, of course, the excitement over the sprinkling of snow! We used our Outdoor Learning time to take photos of the school and playground areas. We will use these in our History topic about how schools have changed. We were also treated to Mrs Davies talking about how this school was when she came in the 1970's. It was very interesting to learn that there were lots of differences (eg only two classrooms and teachers, no big playground area, no technology such as computers and big screens. She explained that if they wanted to watch something on TV, a trolley was wheeled into the room with a television on for the children to gather around. The children thought this was very funny!). We have definitely begun our run up to Christmas! Parts for our Nativity scene have been allocated and the children are rehearsing. Please see a letter regarding costumes. Next week we will continuing with this mix of normality and seasonal preparations...Have a good weekend.

## Class 3

We have made a start at practising in preparation for our Christmas Carol Concert. All the children are eager to learn their lines and songs which is great! For costumes please could the children wear a Christmas jumper and if this could be brought in by the 1st December that would be greatly appreciated. In class we have been busy completing our NFER tests. All of the children have tried very hard with these assessments and done their best. In the afternoons we have been looking at different teeth in science and what they are used for. Our D.T. Work has included work on budgeting for our next biscuit making afternoon, can't wait!! Have a lovely weekend everybody!

## Class 4

Friday is here again. As always another busy week. We have started working on fractions in maths and children are quickly grasping new concepts. A little bit of homework has been sent home as a reminder of work we covered first. We will continue with fractions next week. In Literacy we have continued to read Tom's Midnight Garden and have created more descriptive writing alongside listening to the story unfold. As a school we have been busy preparing for the Nativity and children will bring some song words home next week which we all need to learn. We have a few things coming up in the next few weeks including the Swimming Gala on 1<sup>st</sup> December, a letter will be sent out with full details next week. Children are aware of who is in the team. Have a lovely weekend everyone. See you all Monday.
