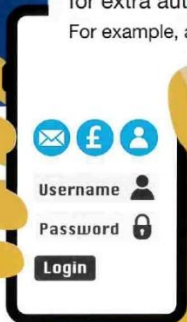

Digital security starts with Two-Step Verification

Two-step verification (2SV) is a simple way to give your account an extra level of protection, by asking for extra authentication when you log in. For example, a one-time passcode.



Available for email, online banking, and social media.

Enhances security by making it **harder for hackers** to access accounts, protecting against:

Sometimes called **Two-Factor Authentication (2FA)** or **Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA)**
