Dear Parent/Carer,

On **Wednesday afternoons**, starting on 5<sup>th</sup> June, Year 6 pupils will begin their block of Outdoor Learning sessions. These sessions will be run by Mrs Orritt and Mrs Garry who both have extensive experience in outdoor learning. These will occur on a weekly basis till the end of term.

We would be grateful if you could ensure that your child brings the following clothing to school in a robust bag or rucksack to wear during these lessons.

- a pair of wellies,
- thick socks
- a pair of old trousers or leggings
- warm jumper (weather dependent)
- waterproof trousers or ski pants
- waterproof coat
- pair of gloves
- Sun hat / Sun cream depending on the weather

If your child does not have a pair of waterproof trousers, we do have some in school that he/she could use.

Please ensure that all Forest School **clothing is named** and placed in a bag. **Wellies should also be named.** Forest School bags may be left in school for the half-term. If clothing is very wet or muddy, we will send the bags home for items to be washed/dried before the next session.

We ensure that children have a biscuit and a drink when they are actively participating in Outdoor learning activities. As this has a funding implication, we would ask for a voluntary contribution of £2 per child to cover the cost. This can be paid using ParentPay.

Please log on to ParentPay to give consent for your child to take part in outdoor learning sessions before Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> June 2024.
