Year 6 Dental Survey

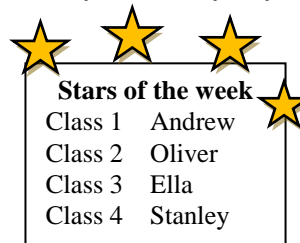
