Any person who would like to express an interest in being elected onto the Council by co-option should contact the Parish Clerk for an application form.

Completed applications to be received before

5pm on Tuesday 30th June 2026

Co-option will take place at the Meeting of the Full Council on

Wednesday 8th July 2026 at 7:00pm.

You must be qualified by virtue of being a British or Commonwealth Citizen, citizen of the Republic of Ireland or European Union citizen, have attained the age of 18 years and are either

- (a) registered as a local government elector for the parish; and/or have
- (b) during the whole of the twelve months preceding the appointment occupied as owner or tenant land or other premises in the parish; and/or your
- (c) principal or only place of work during those twelve months has been in the parish; and/or have
- (d) during those twelve months resided in the parish or within 4.8 kilometres of it; and are not disqualified from holding office by reason of any disqualification set out in Section 80 of the Local Government Act 1972.

If you wish to be considered for election onto the Parish Council by co-option please request an application form.
