# **CLASS NEWS**

# Class 1

It was lovely having all the children back to school this week, after the Easter break, and to begin our new topic 'Let's Grow!'. In Science, we have looked at 'What is a plant?', and sorted living things depending on the criteria. In Maths, we have been looking at addition to 20 and number bonds. In Literacy, we have written our Easter news, completed comprehensions, and continued with our phonics. This week also marked the end of Ramadan, and the start of the Muslim festival of Eid. The children followed a young Muslim family, celebrating this special time, and also made Eid cards to take home. This week we also started our history topic of 'How have toys changed?', comparing toys in the past to those of present day. As part of this topic, please could children bring in a favourite toy from home, for next Thursday (18/4). Could I ask that the chosen toy is not too big or too expensive, thank you. Finally, as we are starting our topic of growing, please could children bring waterproofs (Coat and trousers if possible), and a pair of wellies, all with their name on, for next Wednesday. Thank you, and have a lovely weekend!

# Class 2

This week Class 2 have been working on Place Value in Maths as well as learning the 4 times tables. We have started looking at different aspects of the story, 'The Velveteen Rabbit' in our Literacy work. We have been finding out about timelines in our History work. We will be discovering the differences between the Stone Age, Bronze Age and Iron Age. We are also studying the beliefs of Muslims in our R. E. work. We are really looking forward to a great Summer term of learning in Class 2.

# Class 3

We have had a great start to our new term, our final term in primary school!! The children have been learning about decimals, percentages and fractions in maths and have been busy learning how to convert them from one form to another as well as finding quantities of different percentages. The children were excited to hear that our English focus of extended writing will be based around the book 'Wonder' which many have already watched the film! In computing we have been looking at three dimensional modelling and will continue with this next session. We all enjoyed our 'Bikeability' course, the instructors both commented on how well everyone did. Have a great weekend everybody!

#### Class 4

It has been lovely to see everybody again in Class 4 and we have had a very busy start to the term. Our new text in English is 'The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe' and we have really enjoyed finding out more about the context of the story, including looking at the time period of WW2. In maths, we have been consolidating our understanding of place value, considering aspects such as ordering numbers and roman numerals. In our topic lesson, we have been comparing our local area with the Alps and in RE, we looked at the 5 Pillars of Islam. Have a lovely weekend everybody.


# How to book meals and events

If your child's school makes use of the ParentPay booking service, you will be able to book your child's meals and/or event place in advance of the session. This helps the school minimise food waste and reduce administrative burden on the school staff.


To check whether your child's school uses the booking feature, select the child you wish to view. The bookings option will be available on the child's information screen 'Book meals and places'.

# **Making bookings**


- 1. Login to <a href="https://www.parentpay.com">www.parentpay.com</a>
- 2. Select **Book meals and places** for the person you wish to make the booking for.




3. Select the time of day that you wish to make a booking for.




4. Select Make or view bookings.



- 5. You will then be presented with the booking screen.
- 6. Select the date you wish to book.




- 7. Scroll and tap the **main meal choice** or **place** for your child (this will then be highlighted in orange).
- 8. Tap the arrow to view Allergen or nutritional information (if available).



9. Some menu's may require you to select a dessert. Scroll to view dessert options and tap the desired choice.



10. Scroll back to the top of the screen to choose another day.



11. Repeat steps 7 through to 9 until you are ready to confirm your bookings.


Note: You can scroll through the dates and choose meals for up to 10 weeks in advance (depending on your schools settings). You will need to select the last date that appears, to be able to see further dates.




12. If you pay for the bookings these will need to be paid within two hours of confirming.



13. Tap on the **Confirm bookings**, if payment is due you will be taken to the basket.



14. You may wish to add more bookings for another child, select the **Continue shopping** option.



- 15. Once you have completed your bookings return to the basket and choose the payment option that most suits you.
- 16. Confirmation of payment will appear on your mobile device and you meal or places bookings will have been sent to the school.
