Your voting rights are as follows:

- 1. Each parent has one vote for each vacancy, irrespective of the number of children he/she has at the school.**
- 2. Each parent has one vote for each vacancy, however, you may not cast more than one vote for the same candidate.**
- 3. The definition of parent, in relation to any child or young person, includes any person who is not a parent but who has parental responsibility for, or who has care of, the child or young person.**
- 4. Parents running as a candidate in the parent election cannot vote for themselves.**

The ballot papers will be counted at **9:00am** on **Friday 13th February**, and candidates will be





notified of the results of the election, in the first instance. Parents/carers will be notified by no later than the following school day.
