Class 1

What another busy week we've all had! For the past two weeks, Year 1 have all been doing their NFER assessments, and this week everyone has completed their half-trembly reading tests. I'm so proud of all their efforts, well done! In R.E, we have been learning more about the Easter story, piecing it all together. In Science, we have continued with our 'Senses' topic, focusing on 'Sight' and 'Smell'. The children had to be 'Smell Detectives' and pick out and name a range of household substances, including oranges, toothpaste, vinegar, etc. They were all, fabulous! Finally, the Year 1's have completed their Humpty Dumpty moving books and were thrilled to share them with their Reception partners. Have a great weekend everyone!

Class 2

This week has been one of those weeks with a lot of testing for the children. Overall, they have risen to the challenge, but the last day or two has been hard work for them, particularly in the warmer weather! Well done everyone for doing your best. The weekly spelling test has been carried over to next Wednesday. Next week should be more fun generally, and we will begin the week with a DT Day, making our castles. The children have already done their designs, following the trip to Chirk Castle last week, and are excited to create them. They can bring boxes/ card for home but there will be some provided in school. Other work planned for next week will be finishing our various topics before we end the term on Thursday. Class 3

We have had a great week in the Spring sunshine this week. The children have been busy completing a number of assessment activities which will help inform learning during the Summer Term. Everyone has enjoyed developing a plan for their creative writing task and have worked hard in including relevant detail to hook the reader when writing their 'how to train a dragon' story. The children have greatly enjoyed constructing their torches in Design Technology (See Seesaw for photos). We continue to learn about fractions and decimals in maths. Have a super weekend everybody!

Class 4

Another busy week in Class 4. We have been finishing our NFER tests this week so a big well done to all. We have had a big push on grammar this week, consolidating aspects such as nouns, adjectives, verbs and adverbs. We have also been looking at using the active/passive voice in addition to considering the use of different types of punctuation. In maths, we have been looking at ratio and have considered its link to our fraction's unit of work. We also had a great time creating our steady hand games in science/DT this week and have evaluated them effectively. It was great to see everybody so engaged whilst creating them. We have also listened more to our story 'Wonder' and have developed a deeper understanding of different characters such as Via and Summer. This weekend, there are no spellings but there is some homework which should have been brought home. Y6 have some practice papers to practise. We will go over these on Wednesday during SATs club. - A full refund will be offered after your child's first lesson if they haven't enjoyed their session.
- Video feedback will be sent to you (upon consent from the school and parents) to keep you updated on your child's progress.
- A school concert will be held once a year where you can come and watch your child play live in a school performance.
