## Class 3

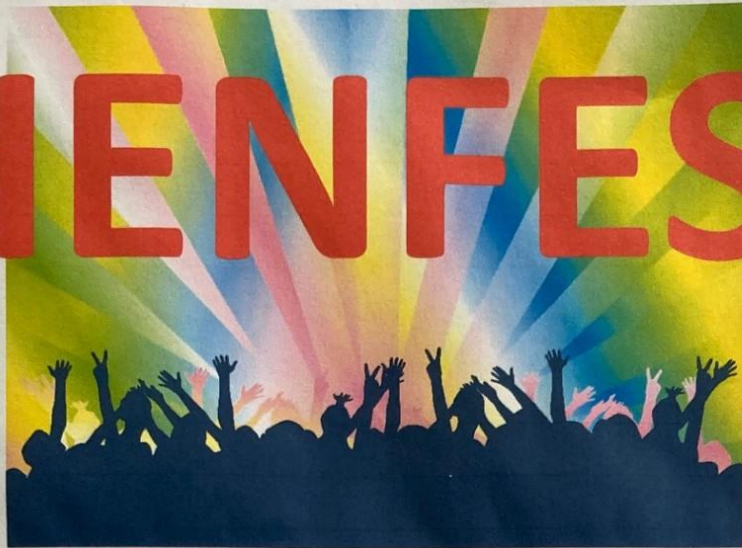
