# CLASS NEWS

## Class 1

In Class 1 this week, we have been revising for our 'Year 1 Phonics Test' next week, recapping over our sounds and distinguishing between pseudo and real words. In Maths, we have revisited 'Shape', investigating both 2D and 3D shapes, and finding out about their properties. We have begun our new R.E topic, 'Which stories are special and why?', starting with stories that are special to us, and then moving on to find out more about special stories from the Bible, and those of other Faiths. Lastly, it was wonderful to be part of Selattyn's D-Day commemorations, and in particular, finding out about Stanley Williams, an ex-pupil of the school, who had been part of the landings in 1944. We were also very lucky that Mrs.Lander was able to join us in class, and tell us all about her childhood memories. The children listened intently, and were very respectful. Well done everyone, I am very proud of you all! Have a wonderful weekend everyone!

## Class 2

Class 2 have enjoyed finding out more about D-Day this week. We have been sharing information about some of our ancestors who were alive at that time and some who fought in the Second World War. We have looked at photos, medals and memorabilia from the time. It has given us a real insight into why this is such an important anniversary. On Thursday we were visited by some local people who were able to tell us about their experiences of childhood during wartime. They told us about rationing, air raids, bomb shelters and a little about what Oswestry was like during the war years. The children were able to ask many questions, and showed a developing understanding of the importance of remembering the sacrifices made by those in the past on our behalf.

## Class 3

We have had an action packed week to start our new half term. We all had a great time with our first swimming session at Oswestry School on Wednesday. This was followed up with our first outdoor session exploring different areas of the school grounds and carrying out a nature hunt. Everyone enjoyed their hot chocolate and biscuits at the end too! In class we have been investigating 3D shape and we will continue with this next week. The children travelled to the Marches Athletics Festival in Wrexham today. All were a credit to the school and performed brilliantly. Another busy week is on the cards next week with our visit to Crucial Crew on Wednesday. Have a great weekend everybody!

## Class 4

What a busy week!! We have been looking at haiku poems this week, writing poems linked to our school values. We have also been very busy out of class this week. We went swimming with Year 6 this week on Wednesday, followed by attending 'The Big Sing' at Moreton Hall on Thursday.
