Science Challenge Day at Moreton Hall

The morning was spent building tall structures, launching rockets, investigating the eco-garden and farm and finally there was a visit to the forensics lab to solve the crime of the stolen biscuits!

We were treated to hot dogs, chips and doughnuts for lunch, followed in the afternoon by a fabulous interactive presentation by Simon Watt from The Ugly Animal Preservation Society who gave us a lot of information and made us carefully think about our need to look after our world. All of the pupils from Selattyn had great fun and were impeccably behaved. They were a credit to both school and their families.

School Lunches

Following on from our questionnaire to parents regarding school lunches we are pleased to be able to offer more choice. Starting on Monday - pupils will be able to choose between the normal main course and the vegetarian option even if they are not vegetarian. They will also be able to choose between two puddings – the main option and either fruit or jelly depending on the day. In addition to the listed menu items children are able to choose additional salad items and bread each day. Children from Classes 1 & 2 who have school dinners also get a glass of milk. CLASS NEWS

Class 1

This week in class, we have completed our class book 'Starry-eyed Stan'. The children created story maps to help them retell the story, and then acted it out in drama. In Numeracy, we practised recognising and writing number words, created different number lines and used our sorting skills to sort out sea creatures into a Carroll diagram. The children have also been looking at world maps, to locate land and sea, and then sorting animals who live in those environments. We also had a challenge this week, to make a pair of headphones for grumpy Lancelot the crab. We investigated and deconstructed some real headphones first, to give the children some ideas, then the children went through the design process, assessing and making alterations as they went along. The results were fantastic, and the children should be very proud of themselves.

Class 2

We have had another good week at school and we have enjoyed the lovely weather. Thank you to all parents who have been making sure that sunhats and water bottles are brought to school and that children have had suncream applied before coming to class/have a sunblock stick to use themselves. Checking sun protection measures makes a welcome change from asking for coats hats in school! In maths this week, we have been looking at geometry and learning about position and movement. We have been trying to get to grips with our left and our right, clockwise and anticlockwise, quarter, half and three-quarter turns, rotation of shapes etc. It has been a very practical week and great fun. In English we are looking at persuasive language and we have been debating different issues. Our main question was..... Should animals be kept in zoos? Lots of opinions were shared and all points of view were valid. Some of us agreed that zoos were good places for animals to be, and some of us disagreed for a number of reasons. I wonder if our opinions will change at all following our trip to Chester Zoo next Wednesday.

Class 3

This week Class 3 have been solving problems related to units of measurement, including length and capacity. The Year 4 pupils have completed their National Times Table check.

Well done to them! We have been finding out about the life cycle of the common frog and answering questions about it. In P.E. we have been practicing tennis skills and we have been doing some research about endangered animals ahead of our visit to Chester

Class 4

We have all been working hard as usual in the glorious summer weather we are receiving this week. The Year Five children had an amazing time at the Science day at Moreton School and carried out lots of interesting and exciting experiments. In class we have been continuing to investigate number patterns and identify common rules. In our language work we have been looking at alliterations and similes in preparation for our poetry writing. We had great fun making our own example lung in science to find out how they work and the purpose of this important organ. In art we have been preparing our entries in readiness for Selattyn Show!
