Uniform & Equipment

- **Daily Wear:** Labelled school sweatshirt / cardigan, polo shirt, and trousers/shorts/skirt.
- **Footwear:** Plain black shoes / sandals (with back strap)
- **P.E. Kit:** White t-shirt and blue shorts (optional leggings / joggers in winter)
- **Everyday Essentials:** Labelled water bottle, book bag, and coat.

Online Learning

Login details for the following platforms are given to all children to use at home. We encourage you to access these platforms with your child multiple times a week from home.

- **Bug Club Reading**- Children can enjoy reading books online while developing their fluency, confidence and comprehension skills.
- **Times Table Rockstars** – Children will practise their multiplication facts both at home and in school.
- **Spelling Frame**- Children can practise their weekly spelling patterns through fun games and activities both at home and in school. Spelling tests are held every Friday.

Afternoon learning

- Topics for History and Geography will include The Romans, Ancient Maya Civilisation, The Rainforest, plus others
- In Science, we will cover habitats, the body, energy and more.
- In Art and design & Technology we will cover nutrition, drawing skills designing planning and making useful equipment.
- Computing will cover skills to use digital equipment from Ipads to computers.
- French we will continue to access Languagenut covering skills such as, reading, writing, speaking and listening.
- Music will link in at times to the others subjects such as rainforests and romans.

School Lunches

School lunches are provided by 'abm' catering based at Woodside school and delivered to school daily. Please order your child's meal from home before 8am each day. Orders can be placed up to 4 weeks in advance.

Meals cost £2.65 each day. All children in Reception, Year 1 & 2 are entitled to Free School Meals.
