Applications received by Shropshire Council after the closing date will be classed as late, which may result in your child being disadvantaged, so please ensure you make your application on-time. Late applications will not be processed until all on-time applications have been offered.

Reception children have completed the D.F.E Baseline Assessments, and Year 1 children have been revising the phonics programme from last year. Next week, we will begin our topic 'All About Me', learning about our bodies in Science, understanding what makes us special in R.E, and making a timeline of our life, in History. Next week, Reception children will start our school phonics programme, 'Bug Club'. There will be a reading meeting for all new parents to the school, on Tuesday 23rd September, 2.30-3.30pm. This meeting is also open, for a refresher, for all Class 1 parents. I hope to see you there. Have a great weekend everyone!

Class 2

✓ Week 2! We have filled it by getting to know each other further and becoming more familiar with the routines. We have also started most of our subjects and are really enjoying all the different topics. We have had lots of practical sessions; in Science, Maths, Music, French and, of course, Art. We really enjoyed singing to and acting out Space Odyssey (David Bowie) this afternoon! In Art we were experimenting with different materials such as charcoal, chalk and pastels. We have also read through our Literacy story, The Tin Forest, and are now reflecting on the character (the old man) and setting. We are looking forward to our second Outdoor Learning session on Monday as we will be searching for minibeasts! Have a great weekend!

Class 3

The first full week of term has been jam packed! We all enjoyed our first swimming session at Oswestry School. Both instructors were very impressed with everyone's efforts! We have been continuing to further develop our understanding of place value in maths and have worked with some large four and five digit numbers. In English we have been focusing on pronouns and adverbs and putting them to use. Homework has been sent out today. This includes a place value maths activity, learning spellings and rehearsing 2x and 3x tables. Our spelling test will take place every Friday. As always please can all children read including accessing their Bug Club account and Times Tables Rock Stars activities. Please can homework books be returned on Monday. Have a lovely weekend!

Class 4

Another week has flown by so quickly. We had a great swimming session on Tuesday. The pool staff said our children were the best group they had seen this year. It was so lovely to see all the children able to swim so confidently. This week we have been introduced to our new book "Skellig" which will continue to read, together with focussing on a range of literacy tasks. 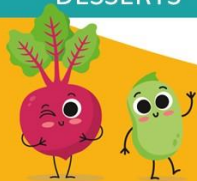
